You can nominate an individual or an organisation who has made major and sustained contributions to the development of personnel in the natural gas industry in any area of activity within the industry. The award recognises a contribution over and above the call of duty (it does not recognise contributions to a specific company but rather to the whole industry).

Nominees will be judged on their overall contribution, including through their actions, initiative, leadership in the industry and the broader Australasian community.

Person of the Year Award

Nomination submission guidelines

You can nominate an individual who has made a major and sustained contribution to the natural gas industry in any area of activity within the industry. The award recognises a contribution over and above the call of duty (it does not recognise contributions to a specific company but rather to the whole industry).

Nominees will be judged on their overall contribution, including through their actions, initiative, leadership in the industry and the broader Australasian community, any other specific achievements such as recognition through other awards, grants or funding etc.

The person of the year can be someone who has had a long affinity with the industry and has over-time contributed much to the industry, or to someone new who has made a recent, but lasting and significant impact. Age is no barrier to the Person of the Year Award.
